Is Your Organization Seeking Funding?

The first step in seeking funding from the Sisters of Charity Foundation of Canton is to complete our online Letter of Inquiry (LOI) Form. We accept LOI forms on a rolling basis. However, we must receive your form by the following due dates to be considered during the upcoming grant cycles:

- **Responsive grant applications:**
February 1, May 1, August 1, and November 1
- **Good Samaritan grant applications:**
May 1 and November 1

Although it's not required, we strongly encourage organizations to send a representative to our Grant Application Process Workshop held once per year. Participants learn about our grantmaking strategies, proposal guidelines, and application process. Foundation staff members will be on hand to answer questions.
